

Registration

After registering your 5 year guarantee, your Dyson light will be covered for parts and labour for 5 years from the date of purchase, subject to the terms of the guarantee. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

BEFORE USING THIS LIGHT READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS AND CAUTIONARY MARKINGS IN THIS MANUAL AND ON THE LIGHT

When using any electrical appliance, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:



WARNING

These warnings apply to the light, and also where applicable to chargers or mains adaptors.

TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE, ELECTRIC SHOCK, OR INJURY:

- This Dyson light can be used by persons with reduced physical, sensory or reasoning capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, only if they have been given supervision or instruction by a responsible person concerning use of the light in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Cleaning and maintenance shall not be performed by children.
- Do not allow to be used as a toy. Close attention is necessary when the light is used near children.
- 3. Ensure light is fully assembled in line with the instructions before use.
- 4. Suitable for indoor use only 0°C (32°F) 40°C (104°F).
- Use only as described in this Dyson
 Operating Manual. Do not carry out any
 maintenance other than that advised by the
 Dyson Helpline.
- If the light is not working as it should, has received a sharp blow, has been dropped,



- damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, do not use and contact the Dyson Helpline.
- If a service or repair is needed, contact the Dyson Helpline so we can discuss the available options. Do not disassemble the light as incorrect reassembly may result in an electric shock or fire.
- 8. Do not handle any part of the light, cable or plug with wet hands.
- Do not use with a damaged cable or plug.
 If the supply cable is damaged it must be replaced by Dyson, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- Do not stretch the cable or place the cable under strain. Keep cable away from heated surfaces.
- 11. Do not route the cable under furniture or appliances. Do not cover cable with throw rugs, runners or similar coverings. Arrange cable away from traffic area and where it will not be tripped over.
- Do not unplug by pulling on the cable.
 To unplug, grasp the plug, not the cable. The use of an extension cable is not recommended.
- Turn off all controls before unplugging. Unplug from socket when not in use for extended periods. To avoid a tripping hazard, safely coil the cable.
- 14. Do not use near furnaces, fireplaces, stoves or other high temperature heat sources.
- 15. The light source is not replaceable; when the light source reaches its end of life, the whole light shall be replaced. End of life replacement is not covered under the guarantee.








It is important that the light is assembled in the box as shown. Do not remove the transit tape until the light is fully assembled.







Colour temperature






Brightness

Automatically changes the brightness and colour, according to your geographical location, throughout the day when connected by Bluetooth® wireless technology to the Dyson Link app.




The light will turn off after 2 minutes if no presence is detected.




Disabling/Enabling Bluetooth® wireless technology


The light has Bluetooth® wireless technology enabled by default.

Press and hold the middle button until the LED lights on the three buttons blink. The main light source will turn off and then on again to show that Bluetooth has been disabled.

To re-enable Bluetooth, repeat the instructions above. The main light will blink twice to show that Bluetooth has been re-enabled.

- Where this light is sold outside of the EU, this guarantee will only be valid if the light is used in the country in which it was sold.

will only be valid (i) if the light is used in the country
in which it was sold or (ii) if the light is used in
Austria, Belgium, France, Germany, Ireland, Italy,
Netherlands, Spain or the United Kingdom and the

WHAT IS NOT COVERED

Dyson does not guarantee the repair or replacement of a light where a defect is the result of:

- Damage caused by not carrying out any recommended maintenance of the light.
- Accidental damage, faults caused by negligent use or care, misuse, neglect, carelessness, operation or handling of the light which is not in accordance with the Dyson Operating Manual.
- Use of the light for anything other than the use it is designed for.
- Use of parts not assembled or installed in accordance with the instructions of Dyson.
- Use of parts and accessories which are not genuine Dyson components.
- Faulty installation (except where installed by Dyson).
- Repairs or alterations carried out by parties other than Dyson or its authorised agents.
- Normal wear and tear (e.g. fuse etc.).
